

## **Special War Workers WW1**

### **CHAPPELL, G. L. (Miss), Special War Worker**

This lady offered her services for work of National importance during the war, and from September 1916 until the cessation of hostilities was engaged at the T.N.T. explosive Works at Chaul End, Luton. Her duties which consisted in the inspection of 106 fuses were of a responsible and highly dangerous nature, and she carried them out with great care and efficiency, and in an entirely satisfactory manner.

### **CUMBERLAND, T. S., Special War Worker**

He was engaged on munition work at Luton, being too young to join the Service, and was employed on various important work. His duties, which were of a responsible nature, were carried out in an efficient manner and he rendered valuable service during the war.

### **Harris, Lillian, Special War Worker**

Worked at the Chaul End fuse-filling factory. Injured in an accident on March 3<sup>rd</sup> 1918 and died on March 5<sup>th</sup> in the Bute Hospital.

### **JONES, A. L. (Miss), Special War Worker.**
